Vice Chairman Slough called the meeting to order at 7:00PM.

The minutes of September 21, 2011 were approved as corrected.

Citizens: John Yanoscak of 700 W Market Street was present to make the Authority aware that the manhole located behind his property has popped several times during these heavy rain events. He is concerned about their health and safety. Drum Excavating will be looking into corrected drainage issues behind the property. Elevations will be shot to make sure the manhole is at the proper height. A motion was made by Showers and English to hire Drum Excavating to verify elevation levels. All were in favor.

RUS was present to get a status on the Williamstown Borough Sewer Plant Upgrade Project. RUS would like to close no later than December 2011. John Williams of RUS will be setting up a meeting with DEP to discuss the pump station 1 issues the week of October 17, 2011.

An executive session was held from 8:10PM until 10:02PM for legal matters.

A motion was made by Slough and Miller to rescind their motion at the April 2011 meeting to have all Authority vehicles taken to K&C Auto Body. All were in favor.

A motion was by Miller and Neidlinger to approve the water and sewer bills for September 2011. All were in favor.
